A Nurse Practitioner will be required to work with medical staff members such as Program Directors, Office Managers, Nurses, and front office staff depending on the type of work setting.

Someone who exhibits independence, uses discretion, and has sound judgment. They have excellent organizational skills and have a keen attention to detail to ensure the best outcomes for their patients.

Nurse Practitioner responsibilities include:

- Providing health promotion, prevention, and treatments to patients
- Diagnosing and treating acute and chronic conditions such as diabetes, high blood pressure, infections, and injuries
- Prescribing medications when needed to ensure patient health and well-being
